DAY 9: EGG MATH GAMES

MATERIALS NEEDED FOR TODAY:

- empty egg carton
- black marker
- 2 coins OR dice OR marbles OR buttons OR rocks

DIRECTIONS:

1. Using the marker, write the digits 0-10 in the holes of the egg carton. One number is written twice.
2. Decide if you will play using addition, subtraction, or multiplication.
3. The first player will place the 2 small objects in the egg carton, close the carton, shake the objects around, and then find the sum/difference/product of the 2 numbers where the objects landed. Their answer is the number of points they earn.
4. Play continues clockwise. Each player keeps track of their own points.
5. The first person to get to the target number is the winner!

NOTE: Students in grades K-2 can play using addition or subtraction. Younger students might need manipulatives (beans, cotton balls, buttons) to help figure out the answer. Kindergarteners might work towards a target number of 30, whereas a second grader might work towards a target number of 100. For multiplication, start with a target number of 250 and adjust accordingly.

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
